Re: Suspension Notice for Department of Agriculture Grant Agreement to organize Illinois-restricted thoroughbred horse races and distribute owners' awards for the term July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2015

Dear Mr. Petrillo:

This written notice is to inform Arlington Park that the Illinois Department of Agriculture ("IDOA") is suspending the Grant Agreement for organization of Illinois-restricted thoroughbred races and distribution of owners' awards, effective immediately, pursuant to Section 6. Availability of Appropriations of the Grant Agreement due to insufficient appropriation of funds. **This suspension requires that Arlington Park immediately cease incurring additional obligations, costs or spending any further grant funds until further notice.**

In addition, Arlington Park is required to submit a financial expense report by two weeks from the date of this letter detailing all expenditures grantee incurred from December 31, 2014, through the date of this letter.
